Hi All,

I have attached a few helpful things I've come across that may also assist you.

Firstly, a guide to putting up media statements is attached. We're in the process of updating the rather out of date email list left to us by Labor and have already fixed the system so media don't need to log on to read alerts/media releases.

The second document is the administrative arrangements list for Ministers, which I've personally found useful when determining who owns which issue. This is a bit of an evolving document at the moment, but this is the most recent version.

Thirdly, the most up to date media adviser contact list is attached for your reference. This document is also a moving feast but should be finalised shortly.

APPROVALS PROCESS - MEDIA RELEASES:

The approvals process with the Government Media Unit in relation to press releases remains in place – this was sent around by Lee a few weeks ago but I'm sending again for newbies (see below)

- All Ministerial Media Releases need to be approved by the Media Unit before release.
- Monday to Friday send final drafts to Aaron Wakeley and Peter McCarthy.
- Weekends send them to the advisor-on-duty (notification of who is on duty will be sent every Friday).
- They'll get the release back to you as quickly as possible.
- Any delay, give them a call.
- Any draft réleases on matters of significance should be cc-ed to Scott, Kylie and Lee.

As a general rule, all media releases should come with a set of talking points which should also be sent through for approval.

As discussed at the media meeting today, media responses/comment on sensitive issues must be run past Lee Anderson and Scott Whitby for approval before being sent.

Please BCC all final comment from your minister to the Premier's Media Team, the Government Media Unit and Kate Wilson (Social Media) so that the Premier is also across it. The easiest thing to do is to set up a contact list which you BCC into every response.






DIGITAL RECORDERS AND TRANSCRIPTION SOFTWARE:

I would recommend you also call IT services on x46358 and ask for Matt Dean, who will install Express Scribe on your computer. Express Scribe is transcription software (with foot pedal and earphones) which will allow you to listen back to the audio and type up anything relevant. Some offices are planning on doing full transcripts of all media appearances, but this is obviously difficult for others due to resourcing.

SHARED DRIVE:

I am in the process of setting up a shared drive, where we can dump large files if we need to share them. You will all get access to this file.

Short Title

1. This order in council may be cited as the Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 3) 2012.

Administrative Arrangements

- 2. (1) The public business of the State is distributed among Ministers as set out in the Schedule.
 - (2) Each Minister is to administer the matters set out in the Schedule next to the Minister's title as follows:
 - (a) the matters connected with the public business of the State listed under the heading 'Principal Ministerial Responsibilities';
 - (b) the legislation listed under the heading 'Acts Administered'; and
 - (c) the administrative units listed under the heading 'Administrative Units'.
 - (3) Information in the Schedule under the heading 'Responsible Heads' is included for information only and does not form part of this order.

Repeal of earlier Administrative Arrangements

3. The Administrative Arrangements Order (No./2) 2012 is repealed.
