As you are aware the Premier sought independent advice on the State's financial position through the Independent Commission of Audit. The Commission's <u>Interim report</u> was released on 15 June 2012. (<u>http://www.commissionofaudit.qld.gov.au/reports/interim-report.php</u>)

The Government needs to make some tough decisions over the coming years to ensure that we set Queensland on the course for recovery. It is imperative that Queenslanders are made aware of how and where to access the Interim Report and to review the options recommended by the Commission designed to achieve the necessary budget savings over the next three years. While this information has been reported in the media last week, we want to maximise every opportunity to ensure Queenslanders understand this position.

Therefore, the Premier will address Queenslanders at 7.30pm on Sunday night, 24 June 2012 through a 60 second television statement across all major networks advising of the Report and asking Queenslanders to review it. A link to the Report will be available on the Queensland Government website (qld.gov.au) on Sunday night.
