Summary of discussion

- Gifts or benefits with a retail value of more than \$150 must be recorded in an agency's gifts and benefits register
- Boardroom lunches are considered a gift or benefit
- It is probable that most boardroom lunches would not be of a retail value over \$150
- Like all official meetings, whether weekdays or weekends, boardroom lunches should be recorded in CEOs electronic diaries (date / time / venue / host) which forms an official record of the CEOs attendance at the meeting
- If there is any doubt of the value of a boardroom lunch, or if it is a lunch outside the boardroom (eg. Restaurant), in addition to the electronic diary entry, a separate declaration should be recorded in the agency's gifts and benefits register
- Memberships in the Chairman's Lounge is considered a gift or benefit and should be recorded in an agency's gifts and benefits register

I think it is worth noting that where the value of a lunch or gift cannot be qualified, the value can be noted as "not quantified".

I am not sure about your 5th dot point. I thought that an electronic diary record is sufficient, and provided details (including value if it is over \$150 or noted as "not quantified") are included, a separate inclusion in the gifts and benefits register is not necessary. On this basis, no events which are recorded in the diary would need separate disclosure.

Before discussing membership of the Chairman's Lounge, I would like to understand who is offered to it (I wouldn't like to raise the issue in the larger forum if only a couple of us are members). However, I agree I should declare it.

Thanks Jon and David for your replies.

I take your comments re "not quantified" or "not determined"

Re the 5th dot point, and the inclusion of a Register entry in addition to the electronic diary (or a copy of the electronic diary entry in the Register), it is probably a matter of judgement and practice for each CEO in how they assess and process "not quantified". Some may want it on the Register which is a stand alone document for full disclosure reasons, others may feel that this is not necessary given their assessment of "not quantified" is below the required \$150 threshold for including on the Register. Either practice would seem fine (so long as there is a diary entry) however I would suggest that any board lunch outside the boardroom should be treated with caution and included separately in the Register.

I will get further advice on the Chairman's Lounge.

2012 Brisbane Racing Carnival


