I confirm that it is my intention to remove my company from the Queensland Register as I will not be undertaking lobbying activities in accordance with the definition in the Queensland Contact with Lobbyist Code.

It is my intention to continue a business relationship with Leighton Contractors Pty Ltd. As I have said to you in the past and also in public my work with Leighton Contractors is not of a lobbying nature but I included the company on the Register out of a sense of caution.




