**Terms of Reference** 

October 2023

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

This document outlines the purpose, composition, responsibilities and operating guidelines of the Department of the Premier and Cabinet-led Future Fisheries Inter-Departmental Governance Committee (FF IDC).

#### 2. BACKGROUND

The Independent Future Fisheries Taskforce ('the Taskforce') was announced on 17 July 2023 to advise the Queensland Government on the best approach, design and implementation of a \$100 million structural adjustment package for the Reef and \$25 million impact mitigation package for changes to the Great Sandy Marine Park Zoning Plan.

This announcement formed part of the Australian and Queensland Government's response to UNESCO World Heritage Committee's concerns about the health of the Great Barrier Reef – and recommendation that the Reef be listed as "in danger" as outlined in the Reactive Monitoring Mission Report (the RMM Report) released in November 2022.

In responding to the RMM Report, the Australian and Queensland Governments committed to a range of additional measures to improve the health of the Reef, including the removal of destructive gillnet fishing in the Reef by 2027.

To guide the removal of gillnets in the Reef and interconnected Gulf of Carpentaria and Great Sandy Marine Park fisheries, the Taskforce consulted with industry and scientific experts to develop recommendations that would deliver on the commitments of the Queensland Government to protect threatened, endangered and protected (TEP) species in the Reef, while supporting an orderly transition to a future environmentally sensitive and sustainable fishing industry.



Implementation of Taskforce Report recommendations and related actions will be coordinated across relevant agencies including the Department of Environment and Science, Department of Agriculture and Fisheries and Department of the Premier and Cabinet. Timely implementation is critical and a report back by the Australian Government to UNESCO on the progress on all measures is due by 1 February 2024.

#### PURPOSE

Sch 3(2)(1)(b)

The Future Fisheries IDC is a non-statutory executive level decision-making and advisory body with accountability for ensuring the timely implementation of the Taskforce recommendations. Importantly, there are limits to decision-making function, with final approvals of some deliverables being the responsibility of relevant departmental executives, and Ministers.

There is an expectation that members will brief senior decision-makers on the progress and direction of relevant matters through the duration of the Future Fisheries IDC, which may include the progression of actions proposed in response to Taskforce Report recommendations relating to the design of the fisheries structural adjustment packages, as well as Sch 3(2)(1)(b) which require further policy consideration by agencies to implement.

The Future Fisheries IDC will:

- Oversee development of a final detailed implementation plan for Taskforce Report
  Recommendations, for endorsement by the Premier and Minister for the Olympic and Paralympic
  Games.
- Oversee development of a final consultation plan to inform implementation of the Taskforce Report Recommendations, that will include supporting communications materials such as consistent approaches and key messages across government, for endorsement by the Premier and Minister for the Olympic and Paralympic Games.

- Formalise/document/clarify agency roles and responsibilities in delivering the implementation and consultation plan, to ensure mutual accountability across agencies by DES, DAF and DPC.
- Identify, discuss and proactively manage any risks or barriers to the successful implementation of the Taskforce recommendations within the timeframe for reporting back to UNESCO.

 Where necessary, coordinate and review submissions, reports and public communications relating to the progress of IDC work outlined above.

#### 4. MEMBERSHIP

The Future Fisheries IDC will comprise Senior Executives from the Department of the Premier and Cabinet (DPC), Department of Agriculture and Fisheries (DAF) and Department of Environment and Science (DES), which are agencies with relevant accountabilities for delivery of the Taskforce Report recommendations.

From time to time, other agencies may be invited to participate in IDC meetings or provide feedback when the Future Fisheries IDC is considering issues that have a direct impact on another portfolio.

#### 5. POSITIONS

Members may be asked from time to time to present their departmental positions in writing. It is the responsibility of members to confirm these positions internally including via briefings if required, to ensure that the decision-making functions of the IDC can occur.

Members are to represent the interests and positions of their department and Minister and provide considered and constructive input into policy discussions for implementation. Members may consider and provide reflections on positions of relevant stakeholders. Members will prioritise implementation of the government's policy direction and whole-of-government considerations in deliberations and decision-making.

#### 6. PROXIES

Members are to attend meetings personally if they are available. Proxies may attend, should a member not be available.

Members are responsible for ensuring that any arising actions or information required of them by the Future Fisheries IDC are acted upon, within agreed timeframes, or by request of an extension where required.

The Environment and Planning Policy team within DPC will provide Secretariat for all Future Fisheries IDC meetings. The Secretariat will arrange the meetings and ensure meeting agendas and any relevant materials are distributed at least 3 days prior to meetings to allow sufficient time to review.

#### 10. FREQUENCY OF MEETINGS

Meetings will be held fortnightly or as otherwise required.

#### QUORUM

A quorum is constituted when more than half of the substantive membership of the Future Fisheries IDC is in attendance.

#### 12. TERM

Six months, or as otherwise required to ensure the delivery of government-accepted recommendations of the Report to Ministers prepared by the Chair.

#### 13. CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

Members of Future Fisheries IDC may at times be asked to contribute to discussions, make decisions, or make recommendations to the Government that may, by virtue of one's organisation, position, or personal interests be perceived or actually influenced by factors that affect the impartiality of their contributions.

Where such a conflict of interest arises, it is the responsibility of the IDC member to declare these potential or actual conflicts to the Secretariat. It is the Secretariat's role to understand and manage, wherever possible, these conflicts of interest to ensure all IDC members, stakeholders and the Queensland community can have confidence in the integrity of governance in Queensland.

The Secretariat will maintain a register of declared conflicts of interest.

#### 14. CONFIDENTIALITY

Discussions of the Future Fisheries IDC are conducted on a without prejudice basis and members are asked to maintain confidentiality of discussions.





- IDC noted the draft UNESCO delivered on Tuesday 25 June did not include a recommendation to include the GBRWHA on the list of world heritage in-danger.
- Chair noted that the draft decision commended the progress of fisheries reforms in the Reef and that this attested to the importance of the work of the IDC.
- DESI noted that the draft decision also stressed the importance of monitoring of compliance of reforms and the need to ensure an effective transition to the Reef being gill net free by mid 2027.
- IDC noted Australia is required to report back to the Committee by 1 February 2025, with an update on progress on its actions to protect and manage the reef.
- DESI noted this will be a comprehensive process, requiring it to work closely with the IDC and the Commonwealth government.
